For use by embedded networks and/or proprietors of residential home parks, multi-unit residential premises and other residential installations whose residents do not have accounts with an electricity retailer.

Privacy notice: Your electricity retailer is collecting this information to process the Queensland Government Utility Relief Supplemental Payment (SMB).

This form is only to be used for claiming of a supplemental payment of \$300 for home-based small to medium businesses, including sole traders, on a residential tariff who previously received the \$200 Utility Relief Payment (Residential).

Embedded networks and/or proprietors need to substantiate the legitimacy of the residential customer performing business operations from their residential address, before applying for this supplemental payment.
